Board Meeting December 30, 2023

A Board Meeting was held via teleconference on December 30, 2023. Doug Werner, President called the meeting to order at 10:35 a.m. A quorum was established as six members were present.

Secretary's Report – Jim Buck

The minutes from the November 4, 2023 meeting have been approved and posted on the ELCA website.

<u>Financial Report – Maria Karr</u>

- 1. Balance Sheet: The Construction Account has a balance of \$20,839.40. The Operating Account has a balance of \$29,556.57 and the Reserve Account a balance of \$57,698.93.
- 2. Profit and Loss: We have a loss of \$34,636.05 for the year (January through November) mostly due to 2023 Special Assessment repair costs.
- 3. Financial Review: Has been completed.
- 4. Check Detail: The legal fees for Robert Foster have been paid. The end of the year statement (December) will be completed shortly.
- 5. Miscellaneous:
 - The new QuickBooks procedure will begin in February or March.

- Four owners recently paid the second half of the 2023 Special Assessment. There
 are nine owners who owe part of the 2023 Special Assessment and they will be
 contacted.
- As of January 2024, ten owners are paying their monthly dues through ACH.

Shannon made the motion; seconded by Dianne to approve the Financial Report as presented. There was unanimous approval.

<u>Old Business – Doug Werner</u>

- 1. Mailbox Pedestal: A new one has not yet been ordered by the Post Office. ELCA will not be paying for this replacement.
- 2. Sidewalk temporary repairs by ProSource have not been completed due to weather. Most likely, the repairs will not be completed until spring.
- Outside lights (solar) Shannon
 They are not working that well. Some need replacement and additional commercial lights are needed. We need a quote for new exterior lights. The new system will probably cost \$100,000.00

New Business - Doug Werner

- 2024 Insurance discussion and finalization – Shannon and Jim:

The ELCA is currently insured by American Family Insurance. The current policy is scheduled to increase from a budgeted amount of \$25,000 to \$57,000 for 2024.

The ELCA has contacted State Farm agencies for an estimated comparable coverage quote. Currently, State Farm has responded with an annual policy of \$41,000 which would include wind/hail damage coverage. If this policy is accepted, it would result in a \$16,000 deficit to the budgeted amount and result in a need to increase the monthly HOA fee to \$335 per month beginning in February 2024.

The ELCA is currently reviewing both policies (apples to apples) to determine carrier and coverage. The outcome will be communicated shortly.

- 2024 Special Assessment Discussion Items:
 - Sidewalk replacement for all existing areas where paver brick exists. Two bids received
 - Complex wide asphalt replacement for parking, entrance and through ways. Need an updated quote

 Replace exterior wiring and lighting. This may be a requirement for property insurance coverage

2024 Special Assessment items and cost to be communicated to owners shortly.

- An owner has requested to install a gas stove in their unit. They will need to acquire a permit along with a carbon monoxide detector for the unit.
