OF EAGLES LANDING CONDOMINIUM ASSOCIATION REGARDING PROCEDURES FOR ADOPTION OF POLICIES, PROCEDURES, RULES, REGULATIONS, OR GUIDELINES

SUBJECT: Adoption of a procedure to be followed when adopting policies,

procedures, rules, regulations or guidelines (hereinafter "Policy"

or "Policies") regarding the operation of the Association.

PURPOSE: To adopt a standard procedure to be used in developing Policies in

order to facilitate the efficient operation of the Association and to afford Owners an opportunity to provide input and comments on

such Policies prior to adoption.

AUTHORITY: The Declaration, Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws of the

Association and Colorado law.

EFFECTIVE

RESOLUTION: The Association hereby adopts the following procedures when

adopting Policies of the Association:

- 1. <u>Scope</u>. The Board of Directors of the Association may, from time to time, adopt certain Policies as may be necessary to facilitate the efficient operation of the Association, including the clarification of ambiguous provisions in other documents, or as may be required by law. In order to encourage Owner participation in the development of such Policies and to ensure that such Policies are necessary and properly organized, the Board shall follow the following procedures when adopting any Policy.
- 2. <u>Drafting Procedure</u>. The Board shall consider the following in drafting the Policy:
 - (a) whether the governing documents or Colorado law grants the Board the authority to adopt such a Policy;
 - (b) the need for such Policy based upon the scope and importance of the issue and whether the governing documents adequately address the issue; and
 - (c) the immediate and long-term impact and implications of the Policy.
- 3. <u>Notice and Comment</u>. The adoption of every Policy shall be listed on the agenda for the Board meeting prior to adoption by the Board and any Owner who wishes to comment on the proposed Policy shall be afforded such opportunity in compliance with Colorado law. Upon adoption of a Policy, the Policy (including the effective date) shall

be furnished to all Owners prior to the effective date as required by the Declaration and in such other manner as the Board deems reasonable which, at a minimum, shall include posting on the website and emailing a copy of the Policy to all Owners who have provided the Association with a valid email address.

- Definitions. Unless otherwise defined in this Policy, initially capitalized terms 4. defined in the Declaration shall have the same meaning herein.
- 5. Supplement to Law. The provisions of this Policy shall be in addition to and in supplement of the terms and provisions of the Declaration and the law of the State of Colorado governing the community.
- <u>Deviations</u>. The Board may deviate from the procedures set forth in this Policy if 6. in its sole discretion such deviation is reasonable under the circumstances.
- 7. Amendment. This Policy may be amended from time to time by the Board of Directors.
